Aqua Creek lifts – compliance with Australian Standards

Aqua creek lifts comply with all the Australian Standard and BCA and Disability Access Standards

Australian Standards:

There used to be an australian standard **AS 3581** that covered pool lifts but this was withdrawn in 2013 and is now superceded by the international standard **ISO 10535 – 2006** "**Hoists for the transfer of disabled persons**". The Aqua Creeks lifts are certified to comply with this **ISO standard**. A copy of this **ISO certification** is on our web site.

Disability (Acess to Premises – building) Standard 2010 which is part of the "Disability Discrimination Act 1992"

This standard under section D5 sets out the requirements for "accessible water entry / exit for swimming pools" This requires a ramp to be installed **or** a pool lift be installed that meets the requirements of section D5-4 **or** section D5-5

Section D5-4 specifies the requirement for a platform lift.

The **Aqua Creek Pro Pool seated platform lift** meets and exceeds this requirement with a capacity of 205 kg.





Section D5-5 specifies the requirements for a sling type lift

Aqua Creek manufacture two lifts that meets and exceeds

these requirements:

- **Revolution lift** 220 kg capacity
- Scout 2 lift 170 kg capacity

Both lifts come with a seat or sling options





Building Code of Australia (BCA)

The Aqua creek lifts mentioned above meet the requirements of the BCA
